

Experimental Future 1: Global Future Report: The Future of China's Belt and Road Initiative

- Potential Future A: Continuation: PRC plays not to lose
 - CCP underplays and mismanages BRI downside and loses control. Loss of control at the speed of effective strategy is not something the CCP is prepared to weather.
- Potential Future B: Discipline: PRC Plays to Win
 - CCP overplays and accelerates BRI. Turbulence in BRI nations and PLA responses trigger global financial re-set.
- Potential Future C: Systemic collapse: PRC, Asia or the world?
 - Demand for post-COVID BRI transparency overwhelms CCP; loss of information control and direct influence over BRI member nations leads to instability that spreads.
- Potential Future D: Transformation: Fierce Competition w/ Clearer Eyes
 - Driven to coopetition, CCP adjusts global investment, increases BRI leverage and exploits emerging tech so U.S. and China both win
