

Una Aleksandra Bērziņa-Čerenkova Biography

Dr. Una Aleksandra Bērziņa-Čerenkova is a political scientist and a China scholar, as well as the Head of the Political Science PhD programme and China Studies Centre at Riga Stradins University and the Head of the Asia program at the Latvian Institute of International Affairs. She is also a member of the China in Europe Research Network (CHERN) and the European Think Tank Network on China (ETNC). After having defended her doctoral dissertation on traditional Chinese discourse, she has held a Senior visiting research scholar position at Fudan University School of Philosophy, Shanghai, China and a Fulbright visiting scholar position at the Center for East Asia Studies, Stanford University. Dr. Bērziņa-Čerenkova is a European China Policy Fellow at MERICS and an affiliate of the Lau Institute at King's College, London as well.

Dr. Bērziņa-Čerenkova publishes on PRC political discourse, contemporary Chinese ideology, EU-China relations, Russia-China, and the BRI. Her most recent monograph is *Perfect Imbalance: China and Russia* (World Scientific, 2022).

Dr. Bērziņa-Čerenkova has given guest lectures in several world's leading universities, and her analysis has appeared in Newsweek, WSJ, Politico, SCMP, France 24c die Welt, Libération, Quartz, and other outlets.
